# **FMCA UPDATE**

There has not been a meeting of the FMCA Governing Board since last August, but I had the opportunity to meet with a number of the FMCA Executive Board at our Pre-Rally in Moultrie, at a social gathering prior to the FMCA Reunion and at meetings in Perry.

The most significant news is that Jerry Yeates left the FMCA organization in late February and a management team composed of several members of the Executive Board are actively involved with running the organization until a suitable new Executive Director can be found. The MI Executive Board has seen this Interim Management Team in action and believe FMCA is in good hands.

The dates for the Winter Reunion to be  $\,$  held in Chandler, AZ has been set for March , 2017.

One item that is expected to be on the agenda for the upcoming FMCA Governing Board meeting in August is the possibility of a dues increase. This past year, the dues were held at the prior year level and included coverage under FMCAssist. The cost of this program was covered by investment income. However, as most of us know, that it has not been as rosy this past year and the Executive Board feels it may be necessary to either raise the dues and keep the FMCAssist as part of the dues or keep the dues at the same level and charge a nominal fee for FMCAssist. This issue is still being studied, but is likely to be on the agenda for a vote in August. Please let me know your thoughts so I can appropriately represent MI and its members.

I plan to hold a National Directors Forum during our Pre-Rally in Syracuse to discuss items that will be on the Agenda for the FMCA Governing Board in West Springfield.


Rome, NY, during July of 2003. If you were with us then, it is time to return. If not, in my opinion this is one of the best times of the year to visit New York and Explore!
